

PACKING LIST

- Bible & Pen or Mechanical Pencil(s)
- Sleeping bag or twin bedding, pillow, & blanket. (Dorms are air-conditioned)
- Toiletries, towels & washcloths for shower. SHOWER SHOES/flipflops
- Modest swimwear (girls no bare midriffs, boys no speedos-gross), cover-up, sunscreen, & towel for swimming.
- Clothing that can get dirty.
- Plastic bag for dirty laundry.
- Shoes other than flip flops for recreation. (Flip flops expose campers to avoidable injuries to feet and toes.)
- Flashlight
- HAND SANITIZER (3oz is large enough. They can refill it at camp if needed)
- **CASH** for Missions, canteen & T-shirt (shirts are not included in the cost of camp).
- Prescription medications in original container, with readable current doctor's instructions.
- Bug spray and sun block.
- Dressier clothes for a banquet on Thursday night.
- Back pack to keep items in while moving around the camp. (a cheap sack-pack will suffice)
- optional: hammock for hanging out


What NOT to Pack:

- **Distractions such as cell phones, other electronics, etc.**
- Tobacco, drugs, alcohol, or other illegal sub-stances.
- Immodest clothing
- Guns (including airsoft/paintball) knives or fireworks
- Silly string or other items for pranks.

SNACKS


Snacks ARE allowed. HOWEVER, PLEASE FOLLOW THESE RULES: Snacks must be kept in a sealed container.

CANTEEN


