Conversation has been really great so far and will only get better. A digital copy on Amazon is only \$2 or hardcopies of the book are around \$5 or less.



Many of our favorite movies, from Toy Story to Moana, tell the stories of characters who are on a journey to discover who they are and what they were created to do. The stories in Scripture are like this too, but with one big difference: in the Bible, humans aren't the main characters — God is. In this series, we'll explore the stories of people like Cain and Abel, Elijah, Naomi, Ruth, Esther, and some of the earliest Jesus-followers in order to

The Church is people.

You've heard it said before that the Church is not a building made of brick and mortar. It's a Body. It's a fellowship. It's a community of believers seeking to honor God and serve others. It's a priesthood of believers. It's the Army of God. It is the beloved Bride of Christ. It is all of these word pictures and so many more.

There are so many facets and descriptors of the people called by God. But it is "people". Not "person". It's a gathering. It's the ones called out to an assembly. It's God's words through Moses, "Let my people go so that they may worship me". Pharaoh did not obey the Lord, so God sent a plague. Hmmmm ... a plague. Plague - to smite with disease, calamity, or natural evil. It sure feels like we've been hit with a plague, doesn't it! The strange thing about this one is, we've had to refrain from assembling to keep from spreading this thing.

It's time to turn the page. It's time to gather again. We've been afflicted and affected. We've been incarcerated to our homes and social distancing and mask. We've almost been in solitary confinement. But, the time to gather again is here. It's time for Church to gather to share what God has been doing in and through His people, the Church, during this season and it's time to worship and praise Him for who He is, God!
