# The Big Pandemic Lesson Won't Come from Remote Learning

What it is: In mid-July, the Pew Research Center surveyed 10,211 American adults across different age groups to see if they believed there was a lesson for mankind in the pandemic. <u>86% said yes</u>.

Why it's both sobering and encouraging: 35% of people surveyed believe that there's a message from God to be gleaned from the coronavirus outbreak. That means that there are lots of people seeking to find a deeper meaning in the chaos of this year. Over 3,000 survey participants wrote a personal response to sum up what they'd learned from the pandemic. These responses, from people young and old, are eve-opening. Many pointed to COVID as a wake-up call to the importance of relationships, family, and faith. On the flip side, the big takeaways for many others were political in nature, as respondents pointed to the decline of once-trusted institutions, failure of public officials, and the raging public polarization that the pandemic brought to the surface. Post-COVID, it seems we all agree that increased polarization is bad for our social fabric, but nobody seems able to figure out what to do about it.



#### **DID YOU KNOW**

• 2/3 of Christians came to faith before the age of 18.

• 43% came to Christ before the age 12. (Barna Group)
