While the Biden coalition had a strong showing on the app, conservative and libertarian "hype houses" (groups of content creators) made sure there was a space for teens of every political stripe. One core value of Gen Z is being politically informed, but many of them are not old enough to vote yet. Having a place to vent, worry, and of course, post memes about their preferred election outcome gave them a sense of agency, and it was a meaningful distraction on a difficult night for our nation.
